Why the lone wolf attack happens?

- Though terrorist groups have not succeeded in staging a major organised attack on the West since the Brussels attack a year ago, their supporters have **staged a steady war of attrition**, carried out by knife, vehicle or whatever other means are at hand.
- These kinds of attackers are sometimes referred to as '**lone wolves**'.
- Terrorists like the London attacker know that their violence, **trivial in the grand scheme of things**, will not create a caliphate, or subjugate their enemies.
- Their political project is to engineer a backlash which **breaks up Muslims from the wider community**, and thus give their cause the legitimacy and mass base it now does not enjoy.

- Demonizing the entire Muslim populations, as **Europe's resurgent Right** is doing, will gift jihadists something their bombs and knives have failed in winning them. That is the outcome that must be avoided.

- Intelligence and policing are key weapons to win this long war.
