e-vehicles

- In a bid to push electric vehicles in the country, Government has announced few ambitious plans for mass shift to e-vehicles.
- No permits required for commercial electric vehicles (EVs), state-owned power utilities to set up fast-charging stations.
- It introduced a new scheme for setting up of depots for e-buses to swap drained batteries with fully-charged ones across key metros.
- This is in line with **National Electric Mobility Mission Plan** which aims to get 6-7 million electric vehicles on the roads by 2020 and going all-electric in terms of new car sales by 2030.
- **Global trend in e-vehicles** Norway, which has the highest penetration of electric cars in the world, has set a target of permitting sales of only electric cars by 2025 and Netherlands has proposed a ban from 2025 on petrol and diesel cars.

• Apart from South Asia, the project will track Chinese investments in Afghanistan and Maldives.

 The study will also analyse the impact of Chinese investments including those being made as part of Belt and Road initiative on India's national security.
