## **Brabo Robot**

- Designed and manufactured by TAL, a Tata Motors subsidiary, it is touted as India's first indigenously made industrial articulated robot for micro, small and medium enterprises.
- Brabo can handle payloads of up to 10 kg and manage raw material as well as product packaging in the final stage.
- The robots will ensure product quality is maintained, and this, in turn, will improve competitiveness.
- Since it is indigenously developed, the spare parts and annual maintenance will be cheaper. Except for the driver and motor, all other components are made in India.
