### Global Hunger Index - 2017

- GHI is designed to measure and track hunger globally and by country and region.

\n

- It is calculated each year by the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI).

\n

- The GHI ranks countries on a 100-point scale. Zero is the best score and 100 is the worst.

\n

- The components are -

\n

1. **Undernourishment** - The proportion of undernourished people as a percentage of the population.

\n

2. **Child wasting** - The proportion of children under the age of five who suffer from wasting i.e low weight for their height, reflecting acute under-nutrition.

\n

3. **Child stunting** - The proportion of children under the age of five who suffer from stunting i.e low height for their age, reflecting chronic under-nutrition

4. **Child mortality** - The mortality rate of children under the age of five.

- India ranks 100 among 119 countries with a score of 31.4 and hunger situation in the “Serious” category.

- Over three-year duration, the country has seen a slide of 45 positions from 55 in 2014.
- \n
- According to the report, India is better only than Pakistan and Afghanistan among the Asian countries.

- A highlight of this edition will be the founding ceremony of the International Solar Alliance (ISA).

- The formal founding of the ISA follows ratification of membership by the minimum 15 member states.

- The Pacific island Kiribati became the 41st member to join the ISA.

## **UN Educational Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO)**

- US have recently announced its withdrawal from UNESCO, accusing the organisation as Anti-Israel bias.
- \n
- UNESCO is the first UN agency to have admitted Palestine as a full member in 2011.
- \n
- The withdrawal goes into effect at the end of 2018.

- UNESCO is responsible for promoting peace, social justice, human rights and international security through International cooperation on educational, science and cultural programs.

- It has 195 member states and is based in Paris, France.  
\n
- It is a global development agency with missions that include promoting sex education, literacy, clean water and equality for women.  
\n
- It is known for its **World Heritage Mission** which encourages world countries to protect Natural and Cultural Heritage sites.  
\n
- It publishes **Global Education Monitoring report** and **Gender Parity Index**.  
\n
- It also leads the initiative of **Man and Biosphere Programme** for protecting Biosphere reserves across the world.

## **Srisaillam Reservoir**

- The Srisaillam dam is constructed across the Krishna River in Andhra Pradesh.  
\n
- Andhra Pradesh and Telangana have been at loggerheads about release of water from the reservoir to irrigation schemes.  
\n
- Consequently, the Krishna River Management Board (KRMB), an autonomous board was constituted.  
\n
- It regulated the drawing of water from common irrigation projects Srisaillam and Nagarjuna Sagar.  
\n
- The recent rain brings copious inflow to the reservoir and it is being opened up for the first time in this water year.  
\n
- Nagarjuna Sagar Dam was also built across the Krishna River where the river forms the boundary between Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

## International Day for Disaster Reduction

- The day held every year on 13<sup>th</sup> October since 1989 to promote a global culture of risk-awareness and disaster reduction.

- The 2017 campaign seeks to raise global awareness about effective actions, policies and practices taken to reduce exposure to disaster risk at the community level.

\n

- The "Sendai Seven" campaign which centred on the seven targets of the Sendai Framework was launched last year.

\n

- The first of the seven targets is reducing disaster mortality.

\n

- United Nation Office for Disaster Risk Reduction (UNISDR) acts as the designated agency for the coordination of disaster reduction strategies.

- It is the joint satellite mission launched by NASA and French space agency in the year 1992 to map ocean surface topography.

- It is the first satellite to precisely measure the rising sea levels.

- It mapped global tides for the first time and monitored effects of currents on global climate change.
