Digital Shakti

Polluted White Dwarfs

- It is believed that planets in a system are formed from leftover star formation material millions of years after the star starts forming.
- The research on polluted white dwarfs adds to evidence that suggests the building blocks of planets like Jupiter and Saturn start forming when a young star is growing.
- Polluted white dwarfs are white dwarf stars that have recently consumed a planet or asteroid that was orbiting around them.
- They have thin atmospheres and are considered celestial graveyards.
- Usually, telescopes cannot learn much about the interior of planets but "polluted" white dwarf systems are an exception.
- Spectroscopic observations of such polluted stars can reveal the composition of the asteroids and planets that burned up in their atmosphere.

Carbon Border Adjustment Tax

• The European Union has proposed a policy, called the Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism.

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- It aims to tax products such as cement and steel that are extremely carbon intensive, with effect from 2026.
- The EU has established the Emissions Trading System (ETS) in 2010.
- This provided carbon emission rights to domestic producers in the EU.
- The EU will now be imposing an equivalent cost on imports to level the playing field between foreign and domestic producers, thereby preventing carbon leakage.
- India does not levy an explicit carbon price.

- The double ikat scarf can be worn on both sides.
- Pahari Painting Himachal Pradesh
- **Kinnauri Shawl** Himachal Pradesh The design on this specific piece shows influences from Central Asia and Tibet.
- Agate Bowls Gujarat The semi-precious stone is found in underground mines of Rajpipla and Ratanpur in riverbeds, and extracted to produce a variety of ornamental objects.
- **Pithora painting** Gujarat Pithora paintings, ritualistic tribal folk art by the Rathwa artisans from Chhota Udaipur in Gujarat, are based on the cave paintings that tribal people used to make, reflecting their social, cultural and mythological life and beliefs.

- The Global Shield Plan launched by the G7 group of countries aims to provide funding to countries suffering from climate disasters.
- $\bullet\,$ The initiative is coordinated by president of G7, Germany and the V20 group of climate-vulnerable countries.
- Global Shield Plan aims to rapidly provide pre-arranged insurance and disaster protection funding after events such as floods, droughts and hurricanes hit.
