NCRB is not a statutory body but a body created by Executive action on the recommendations of the National Police Commission (1977-1981) and the MHA's Task force (1985), by merging the Directorate of Coordination and Police Computer (DCPC), Inter State Criminals Data Branch of CBI, Central Finger Print Bureau of CBI, and Statistical Branch of BPR&D.

 - 1. Bhima
 - 2. Dindi
 - 3. Peddavagu
 - 4. Koyna
 - 5. Panchganga
 - a. 1, 2, 3

- b. 1, 2, 3, 4

Left hand tributaries- Bhima, Dindi, Peddavagu, Halia, Musi, Paleru, Munneru.

Right hand tributaries- Venna, Koyna, Panchganga, Dudhganga, Ghataprabha, Malaprabha, Tungabhadra.
