1) Consider the following statements with respect to Kimberley Process (KP)

- 1. It is an international certification scheme that regulates trade in rough diamonds.
- 2. It is a binding agreement that imposes extensive requirements on every member countries.
- 3. India is the founding member of Kimberley Process.
- 4. India is the Vice Chair for Kimberly Process (KP) for 2018.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

- a. 1 and 3 only
- b. 1, 2 and 3 only
- c. 1, 3 and 4 only
- d. 1, 2, 3 and 4
- Answer : d
 - KP aims to prevent the flow of *conflict diamonds* (rough diamonds used to finance the conflicts and topple the established government), while helping to protect legitimate trade in rough diamonds.
 - The *Kimberley Process Certification Scheme (KPCS)* outlines the rules that govern the trade in rough diamonds.
 - KP is a *binding agreement* that has developed a set of minimum requirements that each participant must meet.
 - India has been appointed as the Kimberly Process (KP) *Vice Chair for 2018* & *Chair for 2019*.

2) Consider the following statements with respect to Bru refugees in India

- 1. Large groups of Bru tribes migrated to Tripura after an ethnic clash at Bangladesh in 1997.

- The Brus, also referred to as the Reangs, are spread across the northeastern states of Tripura, Assam, Manipur, and Mizoram.
- Bru refugees are the tribes who had fled ethnic violence from across nine Assembly seats in *Mizoram* 21 years ago. *Not Bangladesh.*
- Recently, displaced Bru voters lodged in six relief camps in Tripura cast their votes at special booths set up at Kanhmun, a Mizoram village in Mamit district bordering Tripura.

3) "Coastwise 2018-19" is sometimes seen in the news recently. It is a/an

- a. Beach cleaning campaign which ensures plastic free beaches in India
- b. Campaign to promote marine life in the region of Maharashtra
- c. Bilateral naval exercise between India and Mozambique

Answer : b

- 'Coastwise 2018-19' is a first-of-its-kind initiative hosted by the mangrove cell of Maharashtra, WWF India and Marine life of Mumbai, an organisation working to create awareness about marine life.
- The campaign aims at creating public awareness about essential *marine flora and fauna* of the Maharashtra region.

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- 2. USA will not participate in the event as it opted out of the Paris deal last year.
- 3. It will be the first intergovernmental summit to be held fully online.

Answer : c

- The United States opted out of the Paris deal last year but continues to be part of discussions as a complete withdrawal — as per terms of the UN convention — takes up to 4 years.
- The United States cannot officially announce its plan to withdraw from the agreement until November 4, 2019.

6) "Heart Attack Rewind" is a mass media campaign launched to eliminate industrially produced transfats by which of the following organisations?

Answer : a

- The *Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI)* has recently launched a new mass media campaign calling for the elimination of industrially produced trans fat in the food supply.
- Called "Heart Attack Rewind", the 30 second public service announcement (PSA) the first mass media campaign of its kind will support FSSAI's global target of eliminating Trans-fat in India by the year 2022, a year ahead of the global target by the World Health Organization (WHO) for complete elimination of trans fats.
- 7) "MCA-21" is sometimes seen in the news recently. It is a/an/the

- MCA-21, an e-governance initiative of the Ministry of Company Affairs was launched in 2006, to allow firms to electronically file their financial results.
- With the shift to the new base year 2011-12 from 2004-05, wherein the CSO did away with Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at factor cost, and adopted the international practice of valuing industry-wise estimates as gross value added (GVA) at basic prices, the **MCA-21 database** also got used in addition to the volume index of Index of Industrial Production (IIP) and establishment-based data set of Annual Survey of Industries (ASI).
- 8) Consider the following statements with respect to Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV)
 - 1. It is a four-stage launch vehicle with alternating solid and liquid stages.
 - 2. India's Chandrayaan-2 Mission is likely to be launched using the PSLV.

- PSLV is a four-stage launch vehicle with alternating solid and liquid stages.
- PSLV has a payload capacity of 1,050 kg for launching into the Geo Synchronous Transfer Orbit and 1,600 kg for the Polar Sun Synchronous Orbit.
- The Chandrayaan-2 mission is planned to be launched to the Moon by a Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle (GSLV).

Answer: b
