1) Consider the following statements with respect to "ENSURE" portal

• The portal **ENSURE-** National Livestock Mission-EDEG was developed by **NABARD** and operated under the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries.

- NASA's Voyager 2 launched in 1977 has become the second human-made object in history to reach the edge of our solar system.
- Its twin, *Voyager 1, crossed this boundary in 2012*, but Voyager 2 carries a working instrument that will provide first-of-its-kind observations of the nature of this gateway into interstellar space.

- Recently, Agni V was successfully test fired from a canister on a road mobile launcher from Dr. Abdul Kalam Island, off the coast of Odisha.
- It is India's longest-range ballistic missile which will be inducted into the nuclear arsenal soon.
- It is an Inter-Continental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) with a range of over 5,000 km and can reach most parts of China.
- It is powered by three stage *solid fuelled missiles*. It can carry a payload of 1.5 tonnes.
- It is a part of Integrated Guided Missile Development Program (IGMDP).

4) Consider the following statements with respect to Exercise INDRA 2018

 - The primary aim of the exercise is to increase inter-operability amongst the two navies, develop common understanding and procedures for maritime security operations.
 - Initiated in 2003, INDRA NAVY exercise has matured over the years with increase in scope, complexity and level of participation.

5) Consider the following statements with respect to Eco Sensitive Zones (ESZ)

Answer:d

- The Environment Protection Act, 1986 does not mention the word "Eco-sensitive Zones".
- The purpose of declaring eco-sensitive zones around protected areas is for creating some kind of 'Shock Absorber' to the protected area.
- They would also act as a *transition zone* from areas of high protection to areas involving lesser protection.
- The width of eco-sensitive zone and type of regulation *vary from one area to another*.

- However, as a general principle width of eco-sensitive zone could go up to 10 kms around a protected area.
- In case of places with sensitive corridors, connectivity and ecologically important patches, crucial for landscape linkage, even area beyond 10 kms width can also be included in the ecosensitive zone.
- 6) Consider the following pairs
 - 1. Heliosheath a place where the solar wind slows down and begins to interact with the interstellar medium
 - 2. Heliopause Outermost edge of the Heliosphere
 - 3. Heliosphere a protective bubble of particles and magnetic fields produced by the Earth

Answer : b

- The *sun* (*Not Earth*) sends out a constant flow of charged particles called the solar wind, which ultimately travels past all the planets to some three times the distance to Pluto before being impeded by the interstellar medium.
- This forms a giant bubble around the sun and its planets, known as the *heliosphere*.
- The place where the solar wind slows down and begins to interact with the interstellar medium is called the *heliosheath*.
- The heliosheath has a few parts: the termination shock (the innermost part of the boundary), the *heliopause* (*the outermost part of the boundary*).

7) Consider the following statements with respect to Partner's Forum 2018

- 1. It is an international conference organised to accelerate the efforts taken to improve the
- environmental health and to reduce the greenhouse gas emissions.

- The previous conferences were held in Johannesburg, South Africa (2014), New Delhi, India (2010) and Dar es Salaam, Tanzania (2007).
- This is the *second time* India is hosting the Partners' Forum.

- The platform has the potential to revolutionize maritime trade in India and bring it at par with global best practices and pave the way to improve the Ease of Doing Business world ranking and Logistics Performance Index (LPI) ranks.
