- He was forward-looking in his outlook and was ahead of his times and he was against bigotry and superstitious beliefs.

- There is **no specific treatment**, however symptomatic treatment can be done to speed up recovery and to avoid complications.

- Earlier the benefit of the scheme was applicable to farmers having two hectares of land.
