- Total 638 drought and flood-prone villages of Madhya Pradesh and Bihar are being covered on pilot basis under this first of its kind initiative. It will be scaled up nationwide in due course.

- Currently, there is only one fully functioning space station in Earth's lower orbit, the *International Space Station* and astronauts conduct different experiments in it.

- It has no permanent offices or permanent staff.
- India is one of the founder members of Kimberley Process Certification Scheme and is the Chair of Kimberley Process for the year 2019 with Russian Federation as Vice Chair.


- The *Aditya-1* mission was conceived as a 400kg class satellite carrying one payload, the Visible Emission Line Coronagraph (VELC) and was planned to launch in an 800 km low earth orbit.
- A Satellite placed in the halo orbit around the Lagrangian point 1 (L1) of the Sun-Earth system has the major advantage of continuously viewing the Sun without any occultation/eclipses.
- Therefore, the *Aditya-1 mission has now been revised to "Aditya-L1 mission*" and will be inserted in a *halo orbit* around the L1, which is 1.5 million km from the Earth.
- Aditya-1 was meant to observe only the solar corona.

- **Aditya-L1** with additional experiments can now provide observations of **Sun's Photosphere** (soft and hard X-ray), **Chromosphere** (UV) and **corona** (Visible and NIR).

• Lagrangian point is a point where the attraction by the Sun and the Earth becomes equal.

- The point doesn't experience gravitational force.
- If a satellite is put there, it won't get deflected, yet the captured data will be accurate.
