- Rotavirus vaccine was introduced in 2016 in a phased manner, beginning with 4 States initially and later expanded to 7 more States.
- The vaccine is now available in 28 States/Union Territories.
- It is expected to be available in all 36 States/Union Territories by September 2019.

- Earth's most recent *geomagnetic reversal* a phenomenon where the planet's overall magnetic field flips took at least 22,000 years to complete.
- This is more than twice than previously thought, according to a study by University of Wisconsin-Madison.
- The magnetic field, which protects the Earth from potentially dangerous solar radiation, last flipped some 770,000 years ago and is named *Matuyama-Brunhes* after the scientists who

discovered it, according to the journal Science Advances.
