- Astra is an *indigenous* Beyond Visual Range Air-to-Air missile with a range of over 70 km.
- The missile can fly towards its target at a speed of over 5,555 kilometres per hour.
- It has a 15-kilogramme high-explosive pre-fragmented warhead.
- The Astra missile has been developed by *Defence Research and Development Organisation* along with 50 other public and private organisations, involved at various stages of its development.
- 2) Tylophora balakrishnanii, Tylophora neglecta are the two new species discovered recently in?
 - a. Western Ghats
 - b. Eastern Himalayas
 - c. Western Himalayas

Answer : a

- A team of researchers have reported the discovery of two new plant species.
- Tylophora balakrishnanii, Tylophora neglecta in **Western Ghats**.

• '*Floor Space Index*', also known as 'Floor Area Ratio' (FAR), is the *maximum area* that can be constructed on a plot of land.

- It is the ratio of total floor area of a building (Built up area) to the total Plot area (land).
- It is regulated by the *municipal or local authorities of the respective State government*.
- FSI norms are usually set based on the National Building Code.

7) Akademik Lomonosov sometimes seen in the news recently is a/an?

- "Akademik Lomonosov", the first *floating nuclear plant* to be built in the world completed its 5000-km journey.
- It causes an excitement in the energy sector, but sparking fears among environmentalists over the safety of the Arctic region.
- The floating plant contains two nuclear reactors of 35 MW each.
- It is a small plant compared to conventional land-based nuclear projects.
- The plant will supply electricity to the Chukotka region, where important Russian national assets such as oil, gold, and coal reserves are located.
- Environmental groups such as Greenpeace Russia have criticised the project as a "Chernobyl on Ice" and a "Nuclear Titanic".

- It is being developed by DRDO for Indian Army, Indian Navy and Indian Air Force.
- Rustom is derived from National Aerospace Laboratory's (NAL) LCRA (Light Canard Research Aircraft) developed by a team under leadership of late Prof Rustom Damania in 1980s.
