- The *International Migrant Stock 2019* is a dataset released by the Population Division of the *UN Department of Economic and Social Affairs (DESA)*.
- It provides the latest estimates of the number of international migrants by age, sex and origin for all countries and areas of the world.
- $\bullet\,$  India is the leading country of origin of international migrants in 2019 with a 17.5 million strong diaspora.
- 4) Consider the following statements with respect to MRI scanners
  - 1. It consist of giant electromagnets which passes radiation in to human body and creates a detailed image of the body's inside.
  - 2. In India, diagnostic centres doing MRI scans must have Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB) approval.

  - In India, diagnostic centres doing radiation tests such as X-ray or CT scan must have Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB) approval, and follow AERB guidelines.
  - But *MRI scans involve no radiation*, and the *guidelines do not apply*. Precautions are taken as advised by the machines' manufacturers.

## Answer : d

- A report recently filed by an expert committee formed by the Madras High Court has warned that invasive species may soon wipe out Shola vegetation from Nilgiris.
- It recognises the deleterious impact of invasive species like eucalyptus, tea plantations and wattle and naturalised alien species like Lantana camara, Opuntia stricta, Chromolaena odorata, Parthenium hysterophorus and Senna spectabilis on the Shola forest and grasslands.

Answer : a

- Five Zonal Councils were set up in the year 1957 under Section 15-22 of the States Reorganization Act, 1956.
- Union *Home Minister* is the *Chairman* of each of these five Zonal Councils and *Chief Ministers of the host State* (to be chosen by routine every year) is the *Vice-Chairman*.
- Two more Ministers from each State are *nominated* as Members by *the Governor*.
- Union Minister for Home Affairs, Shri Amit Shah will be chairing the 29th meeting of the Northern Zonal Council (NZC) at Chandigarh, on September 20, 2019.
- The Chief Minister of Haryana is the Vice Chairman and host for the meeting.
