Let's take 2 instances of

* National skill india Mission

* Saubhagya - 100% electrification scheme.

National skill india Mission

(1) Nation skill india mission ought to provide every year 10 million ~~proyarth~~

long and short term training by having 5000 industrial training ~~cent~~ institutes and 16000 skill centres and 14 India international skill centres for youth moving abroad for work. NEP also want to provide 50% vocational education enrollment in schools and colleges.

Reality - There are 1301 million youth population but only 13% is getting vocational training skill development. It is very hard to achieve 90% and 50% trained population as in Korea and US.

Saubhagya - Harghar Bijili Yojana.

Government aimed at providing every household in villages electrification and announced achieved 100% electrification.

Reality only 1500 villages out of 18500 villages is electrified. 100%. Electrification criteria according to government is a cable line from reaches transformer in village and provide electrification to 10% of Household.

Concls Thus schemes are need to concentrate on Quality achievement rather than Quantity achievement.
