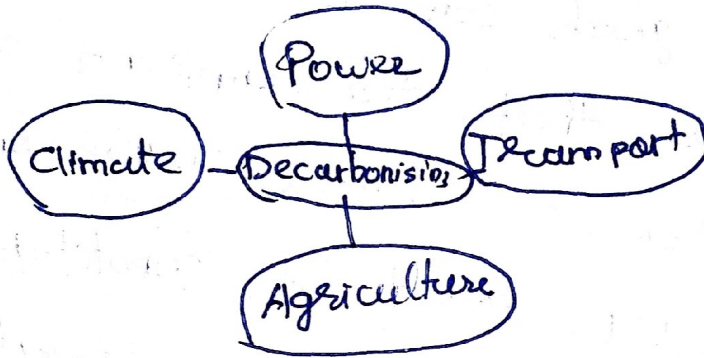


India needs long term planning process for decarbonisation of economy. Do you agree. Comment.

Areas of Decarbonisation



Power

It contributes 68.7% of emissions and government has come up with measures such as National hydrogen energy mission, setting up of flue gas de-sulphurisation (FGD) in thermal power plants among other.

Transport

NITI aayog has selected, decarbonising transport in India dept for reducing emissions. other measures such as vehicle scrappage policies,

Green tax, Farm scheme are in a pursuit to reduce emissions.

Agriculture - It is a potent emitting sector, the government has brought in Green-Ag project and pushing Zero budget Natural farming to reduce emissions.

Strategies

The national goals can be broken to 5 year goals, so that the compliance could overcome. Also a climate change committee

on the lines of UK could be constituted.

The targets must be sector specific and inclusive, with transfer of technology
