↳ 2022 Assessment

↳ suggest groundwater extraction is the lowest since 2004. A decrease in ground water extraction may indicate better water management. However the report itself says that the improvement is only marginal

↳ Critical GW level

↳ In Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh, there is indiscriminate groundwater withdrawal has depressed water table.

↳ Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Telangana & AP where due to inherent characteristics of Crystalline water storing aquifers, groundwater availability is low.

↳ Conserve GW

↳ There is no central law governing the use of groundwater and various states have their own laws on regulating its extraction that
