

What is Judicial Activism? How far successful in checking administration?

Judicial Activism refers to the crucial role played by the judiciary in acting as an agent of social change by pushing the executives to solve the grievances of the public.

Judicial Activism has only been furthered with the introduction of Public Interest Litigations (PIL) to achieve immediate relief disposal to public.

The role of judiciary has only grown Bignificant by judicial activism in the following cases.

\* Pollution in Delhi:-

Supreme court suo moto has directed the state government to initiate steps to control pollution and safeguard the

health of the public.

### \* Introduction of NEET:-

A joint common entrance exam for medical aspirants throughout the country was directed by the Supreme Court to ensure quality and uniformity.

### \* Cricket Reforms in BCCI:-

The cricket body in India underwent administrative reforms with help of Justice Lodha Committee setup by the Supreme Court for the betterment of game loving public.

### \* Black Money:-

In order to tackle black money, the highest court directed the government in setting up a Special Investigation Team to probe black money stashed abroad.

Therefore the emergence of Judiciary in a social activist role has been fruitful.
