NCRB Report and concern :-

Prison static data is an annual report being brought out by the National Crime Record Bureau

the report shows that irrespective of religion minorities are in Prison. ex.

Muslim in Hindu majority states	19 to 21% undertrial	→	1 → communalization
			2 → Poverty
Hindu in Muslim majority states	34 to 39.5% undertrial	→	3 → uneducated
			4 → less representation in govt service
			5 → no knowledge of rights etc.
			6 → ex. Article 29.

Concern :-

(1) biasness :- irrespective of religion if there is minority the majority shows biased nature toward minority. because of lack of understanding or different colour, religion, culture etc.
ex. In 2019 10.5% of ST were under trial.

(2) hostile behaviour :- when majority are in power and minority don't hold any position definitely some hostile behaviour minority will face.

(3) no strict law :- there is no strict law against majority if they lynch, fake encounter, riots against minority. even if law exist it doesn't implement strictly the way it should.
