

(1) PROACTIVE involvement of state governments is one of the best possible ways to combat Maoist insurgency in the country - Analysis

Left wing extremism over half a century has reduced drastically in its geographical spread of 30 most affected districts in India. This is attributed primarily to multipronged strategy involving development and security undertaken by state governments, assisted extensively by SRE → SECURITY RELATED EXPENDITURE of central government.

Proactive role of state governments

1) Police force modernisation :-

- 'Police' is a state subject. Force modernisation, coupled with terrain oriented training has led to effective operations against insurgent groups.
- This involves securing hostile areas, monitoring, terrain mapping, warning systems; district forest guards (DFP)


2) SECURITY OPERATION and Training

- State governments in Maoist affected states have created elaborate OPERATION, that has substantially reduced Maoist

e.g.: grayhound operation → Skilled, Precision fighters that wiped Maoists in regions of Andhra Pradesh.

- Local language and terrain knowledge offer advantages position.

→ SALWA JUDAM of Chhattisgarh, induced people affected by communism to weed out Maoism in regions.



3) Political will → Good governance

Measures

- Government of Andhra Pradesh had introduced 'MOTHER INDIA' scheme for providing alternate livelihood for tribal and landless poor in LWE affected areas.
- Direct interaction of Chief Minister with people of Zargal Mahal village of West Bengal provided morale support and de-radicalization.
- Populist measures for roti bank politics in a way has ensured internal security

4) Surrender and Rehabilitation Packages

- Provided by combined efforts of central and state governments,
- It involves education, housing, employment benefits under MNREGA.
- 'Tribal development focus' and education programmes in Orissa helped immigrants to surrender.

5) Infrastructure Projects and Empowering local self governments

- Road building, telecom connectivity, lighting facilities improve accessibility to denied people; helps assimilation with state
- Local government resource and augmentation increases participation and fulfillment of basic needs. e.g.: Forest monitoring in Kerala, FRA implementation

flow of Multi government measures colluded with central's 'National Action Plan on Extremism' following the 'SAMADHAN doctrine' have proved to be effective development tools. This can be further enhanced by legislative measures 'Implementation of FRA', Land settlement programmes.
