

Indian Constitution has several provisions for the protection of minorities. To what extent are these provisions adequate to extend ^{equal} consideration of these minorities

who are minorities (according to constitution)?

article - 29 - ~~religions~~ ^{distinct}, culture, script and language

article 30 - religious and linguistic minorities

article 350 - linguistic minorities

National Commission of minorities - five communities muslim, christian, parsi, sikhs and buddhist

Though constitution did not clearly specify who are minorities we can infer that from the above provisions

linguistic minorities & cultural minorities! -

linguistic minorities are helped by government to protect their language by ~~from~~ providing facilities for ~~pro~~struction in mother tongue in primary school stage

- article 350

and constitution also placed scheduled language so it

provides adequate provision to protect minorities

article 29, 30 also citizen can exercise his ^{distinct} ^{schools}

language and culture and ~~state~~ government ^{cannot}

discriminate students based on language culture

and they can state their own educational institution

religious minorities!

National commission of minorities has said

messias, christians, shikhs pass as ^{minority} ~~foreign~~ religions
and they are free to propagate, profess and
promote their religion according to article 25
they can manage their own affairs according to article 26
government can't collect tax for promoting particular religion
according to article 27 and students ^{are} free to attend religious
instruction in ^{minority} schools which can be constructed
and maintained by them according to article 28
and more our ~~our~~ country follows secularism
mentioned in constitution and this shows that
our government facilitates people to follow their
own religions

It not only stops (or) prohibits discrimination
it also facilitates minority people to protect
their interest

various other provision:-

article - 15 equality before law

article - 16 right to equal opportunity

promotion of brotherhood in fundamental right

the above provisions ~~substantially~~ gives opportunity
of all religion equally. Thus no one is discriminated

this makes their share in representing our
country and also gives them opportunity in
decision making.

Thus our constitution provides ample space for
our minorities to protect their interest and also
facilitate them to prosper.
