Nehru - the father of modern india laid a strong base for the growth story of india. When he was the prime minister of india he contribute more to the india's growth.

Nehru's vision:

1) Nehru's vision is strongly attracted by the USSR socialism, so nehru brought democratic socialism.

2) Nehru's vision are democracy, secularism, inclusive growth, Non Alignment policy.

3) Nehru set up the important commission planning commission → for 5 yrs planning, which achieve some important desired goals.

A) Nehru's foreign policy is quiet impressive. It is still now followed by many upcoming politicians. He laid down the base for Non-Alignment Movement (Neutral india), which is still prevailing.

③ He describes around 75 of these institutions as "The Temples of modern India" as it touched every kind of economic activity ranging from agri to space.

⑦ When IIT and IIM's are planned ^{name} established a Kendriya Vidyalayas for government officials children and others. These Kendriya Vidyalayas produce new leaders etc.

⑧ Along with large projects, ^{name} also gave importance to promoting small & cottage industries.

⑨ While the idea of smart city flourished now it was rooted in Nehru's period itself. He felt need for well designed modern city, where Chandigarh form an India's first smart city.

⑩ During his period only he bring green revolution in agriculture and dairy sector like green revolution and white revolution.

⑪ His period saw seismic shifts in Indian economy, like telephone revolution change of telephone from being a symbol of elite to mass ownership digital revolution turned India into global tech hub.

⑫ His ideas of Panchsheel policy bring about great impact on Indian foreign friendly relation. By this I conclude that India's growth story is deeply laid by Nehruvian outstanding legacy.
