Recently the Automobile manufacturing Industry of India has seen a huge stuck due to the pause of logistic mechanism from East Asia to India.

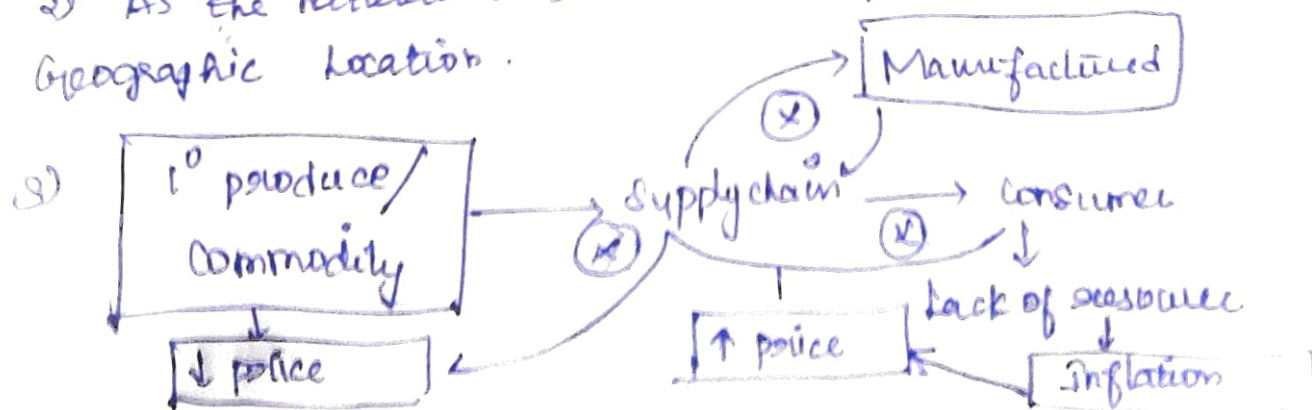
Supply chain Bottle neck:
